

BIC Arrive & Drive Experience **Terms And Conditions**

These Terms and conditions are standard for all Buddh International Circuit (BIC) Arrive & Drive and Track day experiences.

The purchase and enjoyment by you or the recipient of an experience at the BIC is subject to these terms & conditions (The "Terms & Conditions"). Please note that by purchasing an experience you confirm (on your own behalf and on behalf of any other person who may use the experience) that the T&C have been read and accepted and that any failure to fully comply at all relevant times with the T&C may result in your removal from the BIC, Irrespective of whether you have completed your experience or otherwise. In such circumstances BIC shall have no obligation to rebook the experience or make any refund.

BIC reserves the rights to make changes to your experience, or the vehicle used or the circuit used (including, without limit, relevant dates and time).

We pride ourselves on our impeccable safety standards but motorsport activities can be dangerous and accidents can happen. You acknowledge and accept the risk of your participation in an experience.

- Arrive at least 40 mins. before scheduled start time
- Participants must sign the indemnity form and complete all necessary documentation prior to their experience.
- It is mandatory to have a valid driver's license issued by the relevant authority or a minimum of grade 'C' competition license issued by the Federation of Motorsports Clubs of India (FMSCI). Drivers must produce their original driving license when signing on for their driving experience (photocopies will not be accepted).
- Attend the mandatory drivers briefing before driving on the circuit.
- Strictly comply with all the safety and on track rules and regulations as stipulated by the circuit management.
- Do not consume any alcohol/drugs prior to your experience. Use of these items will entail automatic cancellation without refund.
- Participants must carry a certified crash helmet or alternately use one provided by the circuit. This requirement is mandatory and accordingly there will be no exception. BIC respects religious sentiments, but your safety is of paramount concern to us. It is requested that our guests from the Sikh community come to the circuit appropriately prepared in order to comply with the mandatory helmet rule. No exceptions under any circumstances will be allowed.
- In exceptional circumstances when the officials in charge of the circuit experience deem that any driver/participant in an experience is:
 - Unable to accept instructions
 - Unable to adhere to safety rules
 - Unable to remain in full control of the vehicle
 - Makes contact with another vehicle
 - Is involved in an accident
 - Or behaves inappropriate or unacceptable manner

BIC Arrive & Drive Experience

The Session may be curtailed immediately at the discretion of the manager on duty and/ or instructor.

- Please note that some medical conditions preclude certain participants from taking part and that by signing the required experience registration form participants certify that they are medically fit to undertake and participate in the experience. Participants must declare any pre existing medical conditions such as, disability, injury, heart condition, epilepsy, pregnancy etc. to the Management of the BIC in advance and get the relevant clearance from the Doctor in charge at the Circuit medical center.
- Participants are advised to apply for and carry a personal accident policy with high risk cover. Buddh International circuit will not be liable to any injuries arising out of any accidents whilst any participant is within the circuit's premises.
- Participants are liable to pay for all damages incurred to circuit property and to the vehicle while it is under their control. A refundable damage security deposit of INR 20,000 has to be deposited while booking your experience at the circuit.
